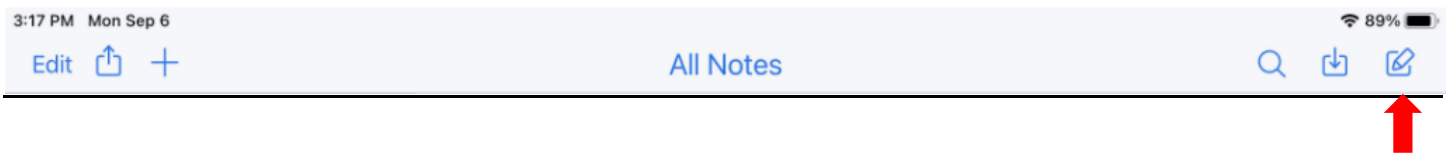


Intro to Notability

Creating a doc:

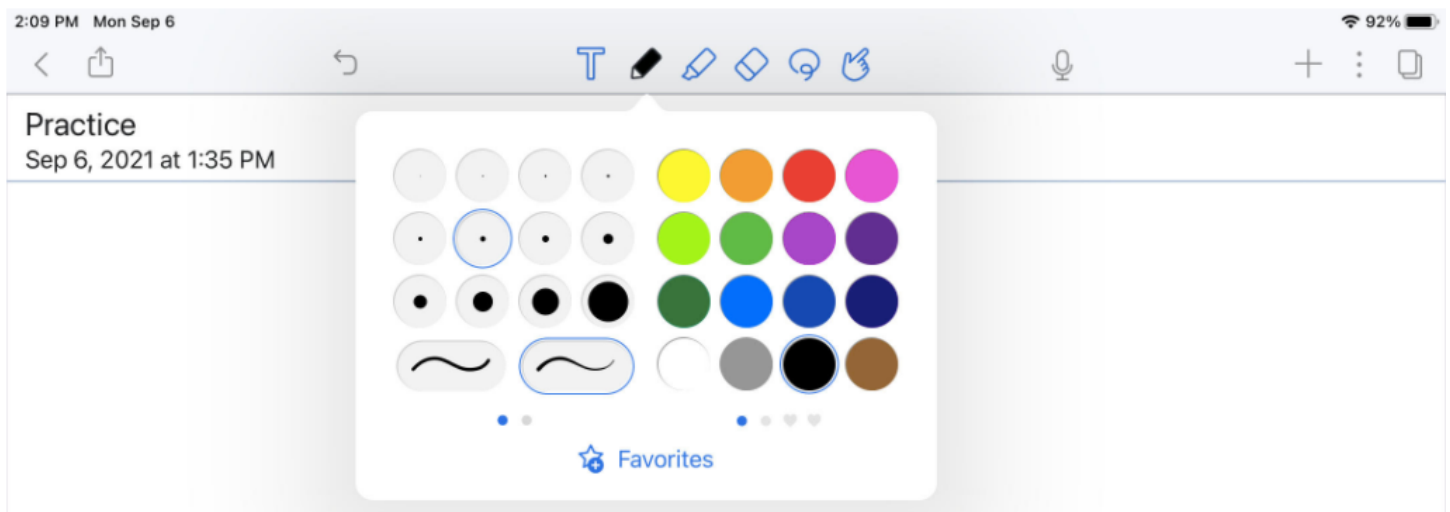


Scrolling through pages:



Use this to scroll between pages without marking up your doc.

Writing with the pen: You can use your finger, any non-bluetooth stylus, or an Apple Pencil.



1. Try writing your name using different colors and thicknesses.
2. Find a thickness that works best for you!
3. Draw a line and hold your stylus/finger at the endpoint of the line. What happens?

Highlighter: Like the pen, you can choose different colors and thicknesses.

The highlighter can also be used for drawing and shading.

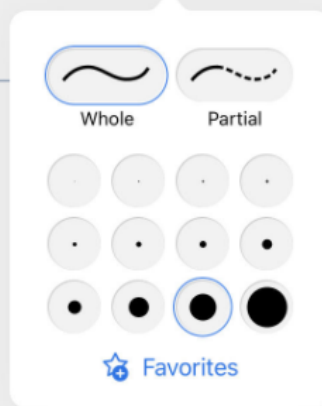
Color in the rectangle using 2 different colors. See what happens when the colors overlap.



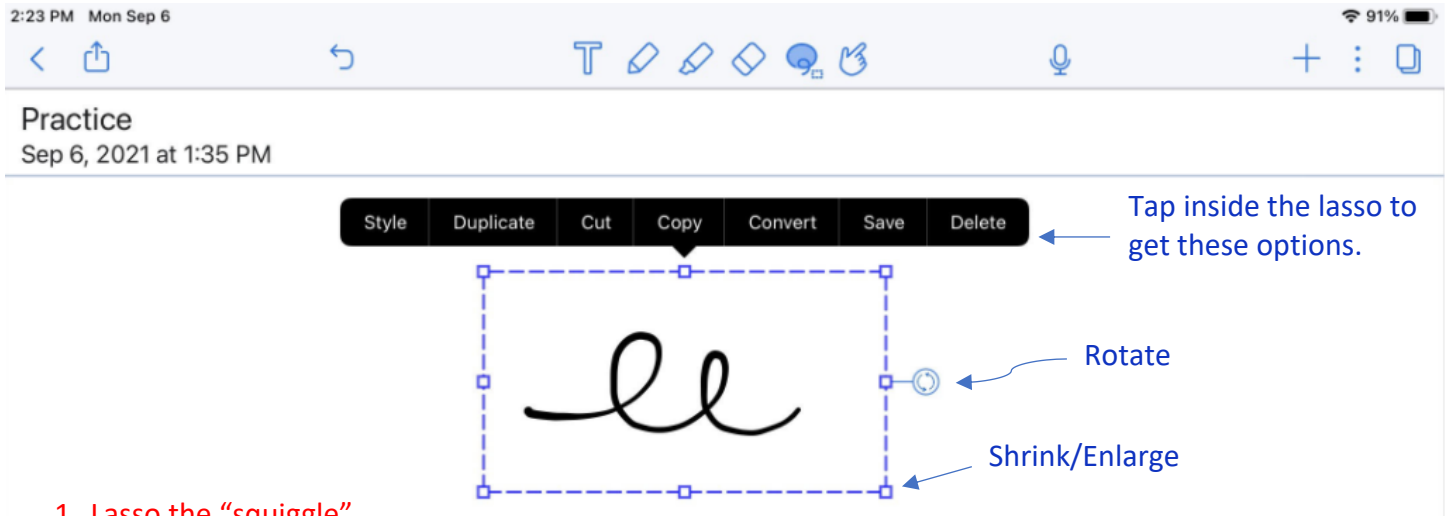

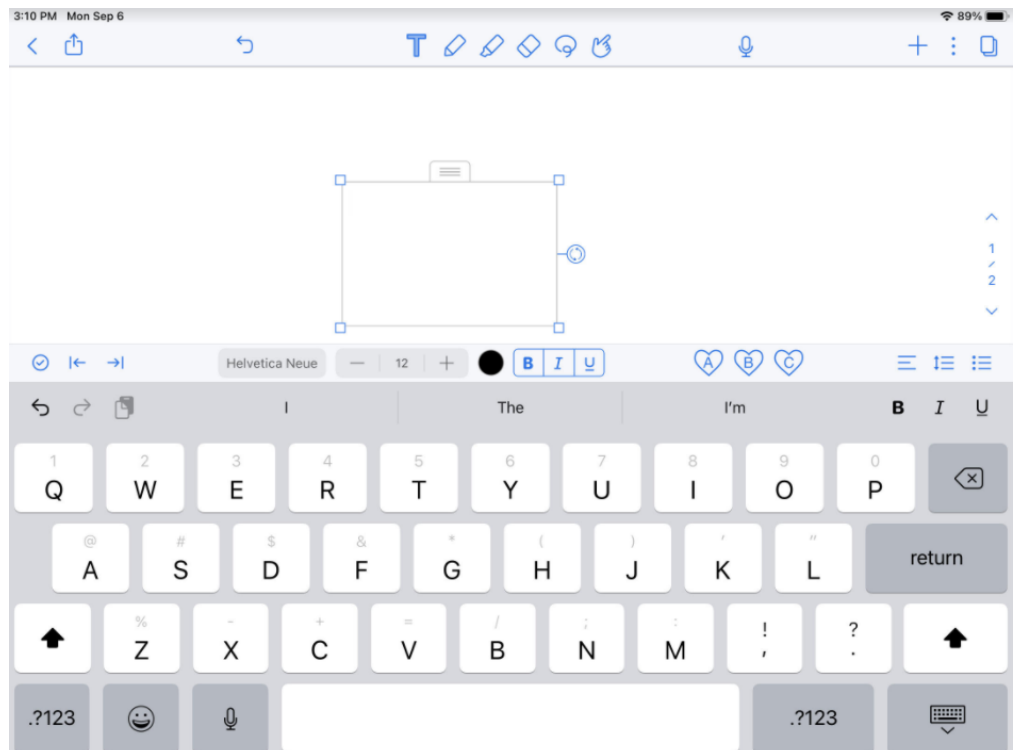
Lasso: Use the lasso to enclose an item. You can then rotate, shrink/enlarge, cut, copy, or delete the item.



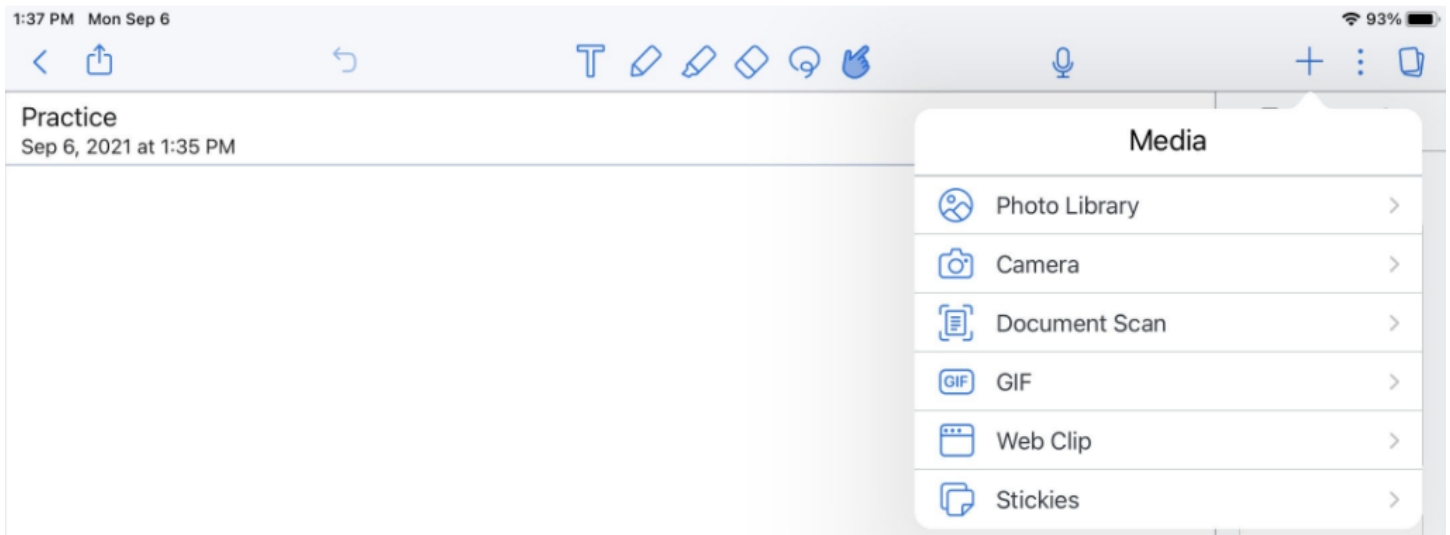
1. Lasso the “squiggle” drawn above.
2. Copy it and paste 4 copies.
3. Rotate one, enlarge one, shrink one, and delete one.

Text: You can type text directly in like a word doc, or you can use text boxes which will allow you to move text around the page.

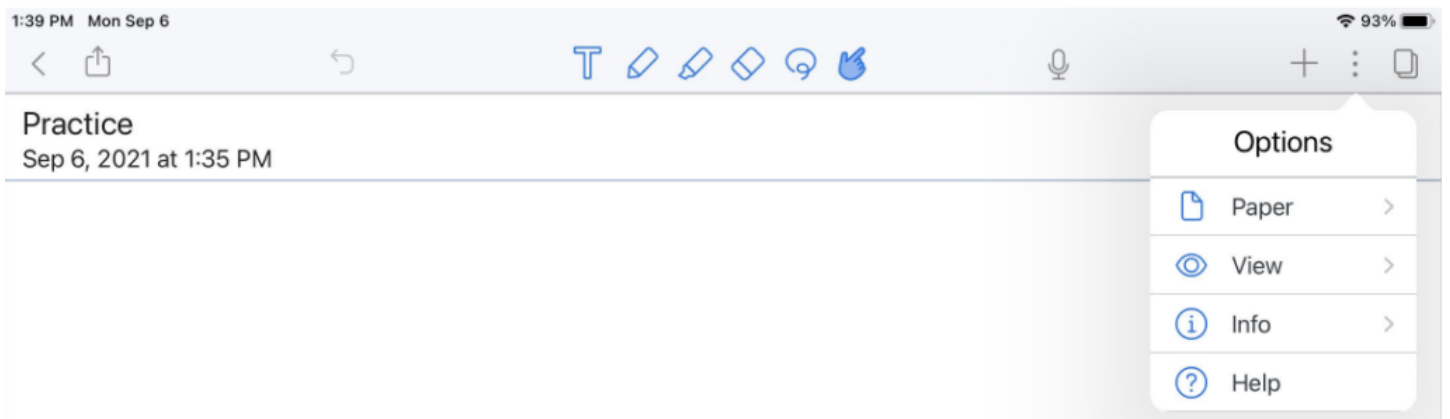
- Tap the “T”, draw a text box, and the keyboard will come up giving you font, size, and color options.
