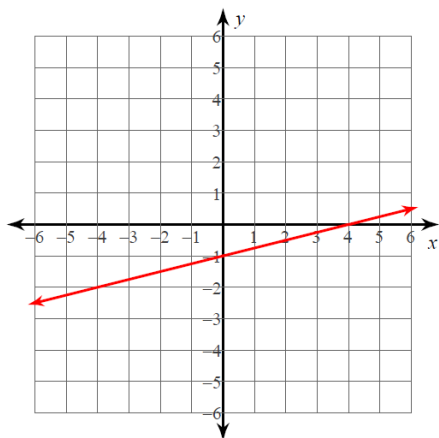


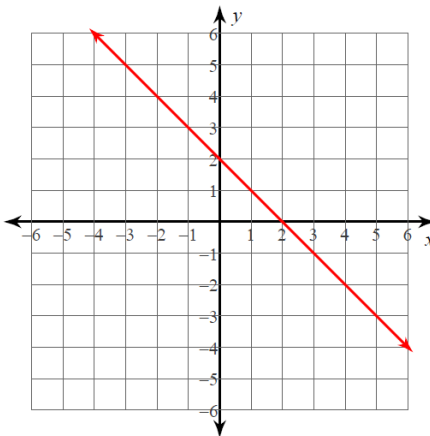
## Graphing Lines in Slope-Intercept Form

Sketch the graph of each line.

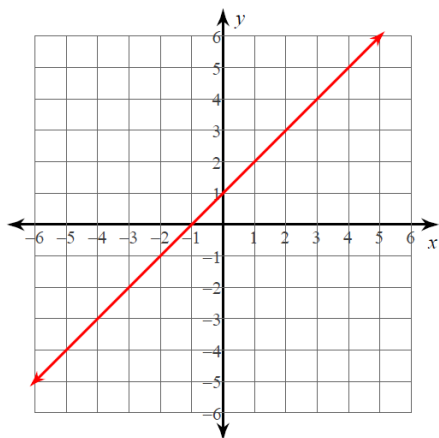
1)  $y = \frac{1}{4}x - 1$



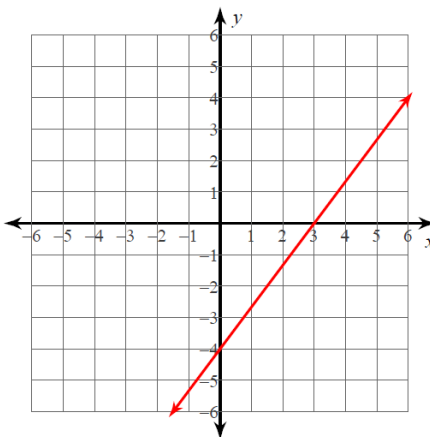
2)  $y = -x + 2$



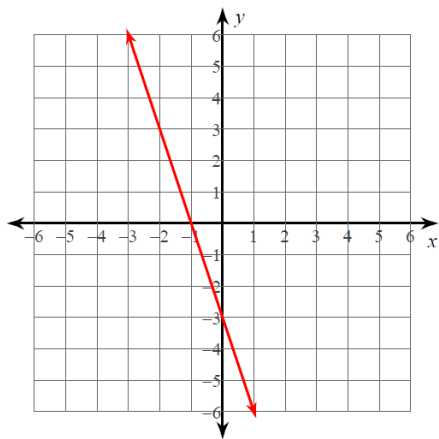

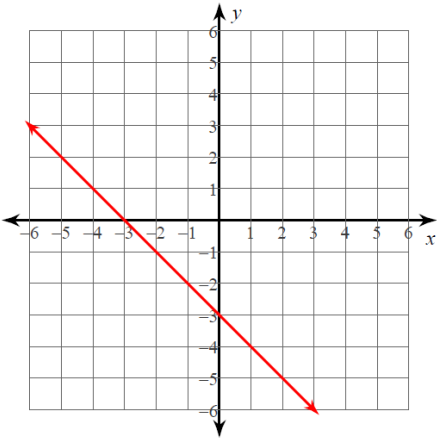
